

## Guide Your Child in His Learning



- Understand your child's strengths and weaknesses.
- Have realistic expectations and achievable goals for your child.
- Create a conducive learning environment that suits your child's learning needs.
- Join a parent support group or be a volunteer at the school to play an active role in your child's education.



## Familiarise Your Child with His School Environment

- Talk to your child about the new school routine, so he'll know what to expect.
- Attend the school orientation with your child or show your child pictures of the school.

## Value Your Child

- Recognise that every child is unique.
- Appreciate your child's effort focus on the process, not just the grades.
- Avoid comparing your child's performance with that of others. Be generous with your praise.
- Make time to play with your child and enjoy his company.
- Encourage your child, especially when he is disheartened.
